Course Goals:

This course aims to enhance students' reading ability with useful reading strategies. The designated textbook provides academic readings materials to consolidate comprehension across different fields. Students are guided from a great variety of reading passages so as to be familiar with contextualized vocabulary and various aspects toward issues. After input from all types of reading materials, students are encouraged to express opinions on related issues with the practice on presentation skills.

Course Descriptions:

Lecture, as well as group discussion, presentation, and language activities will help students get prepared for daily and academic listening tasks. Note-taking skills, vocabulary, and reading skills are designed to improve students' reading ability, while discussion, debate, and presentation would train student's speaking ability. Requirements & Rules:

1. Class attendance, lesson preparation and active class participation are required.
