### Course Goals / Description

This course is designed to help higher-intermediate students enhance their listening and speaking skills through a series of thought-provoking TED talks. Over the course of the semester, students will be exposed to authentic lectures, podcasts and interviews of various topics, from which they will not only learn relevant academic language (words and terms), but also develop presentation skills required for any types of public speaking settings. It is also the aim of the course to help student establish critical thinking skills that help them process and reflect on new information, and apply it to real life situations.

After this course students are expected to achieve three goals:

- to recognize and respond to various types of topics with intelligible English,
- to apply learnt presentation skills to real life settings, and
- to foster a positive attitude toward English learning.
