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Course Objectives:

To develop fluency in the language and to extend the ability to apply it to academic or professional fields. Can see and comprehend broader or longer texts of greater linguistic difficulty. Express yourself naturally without having to search for words to communicate effectively. The area of continuing study will be Contemporary Chinese Course_Intermediate and Advanced Chinese III. ○

Final Oral Test

Regulations for Chinese Language Program:

Attendance:

- Attendance is imperative for successful completion of language courses. Students who are unavoidably absent because of illness or emergencies should report to their instructors as soon as possible. Unexcused absences will result in penalty from the final grade.
- If a student has to miss a class, it is the student's responsibility to find out from classmates or the instructor what course content has been missed and what work assignment is for this class.
