Readying Students for Their Careers Through Project-Based Learning

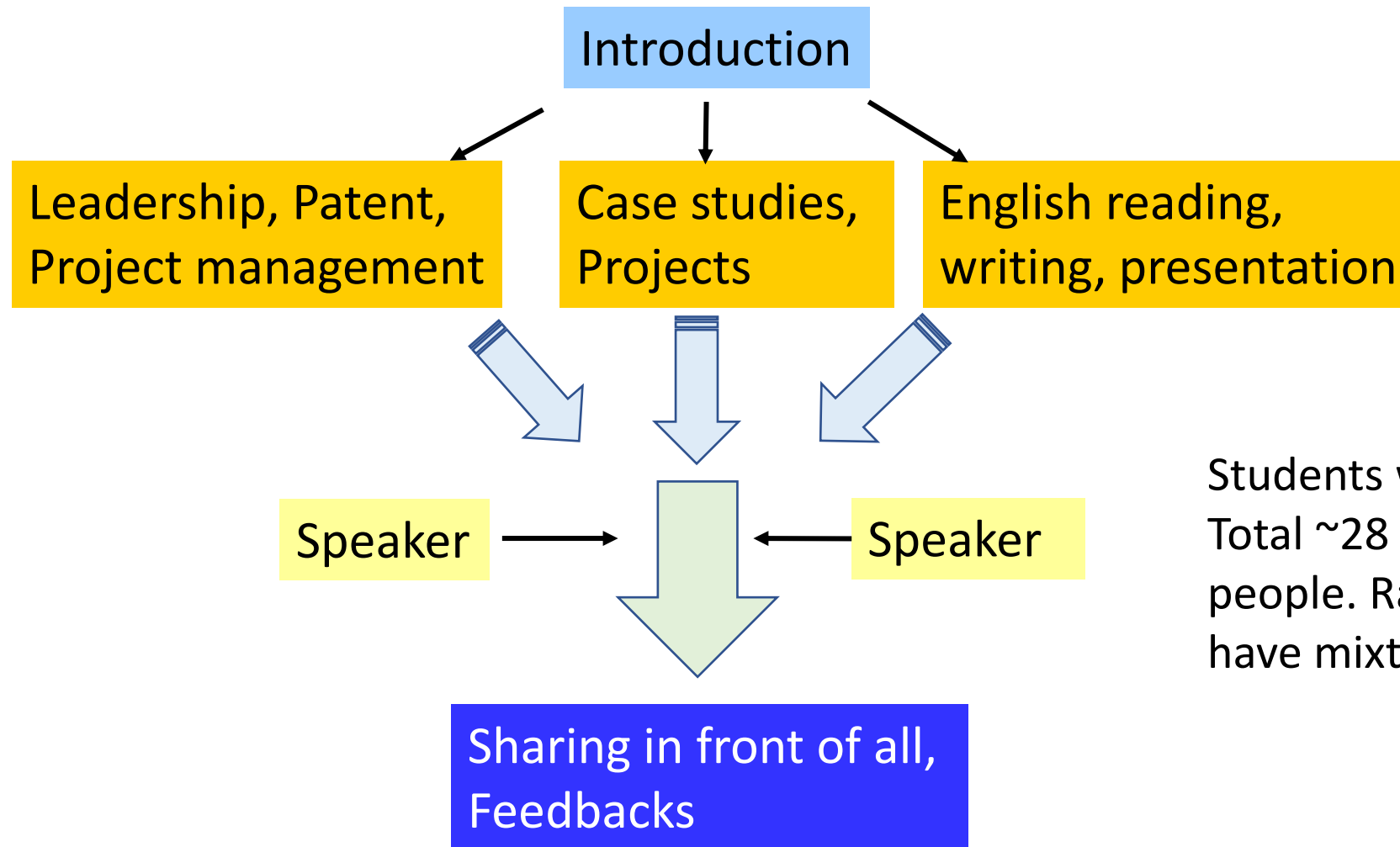
Educators are under increasing pressure to provide students with opportunities to [apply what they are learning](#), and simulations are a great way to do that.

Grading

- For individual
 - Reflection on speakers', ChenFu's, Burn's and ()'s (total 8~9) sessions (15%)
 - Short summary of what you learn. Can be in Chinese or English. To be done right after the class
