一、課程說明 Course Description	<p>This course is intended to provide a broad overview of the many topics in psychology. This course focuses on the mental and neural bases of perception, emotion, learning, memory, cognition, development, personality, psychopathology, and social interaction. The goal of this course is to provide students with basic understanding of the major topics surrounding the mind and behavior. By integrating ideas from diverse perspectives, students are encouraged to relate psychological theories to issues in everyday life. Students will also learn to treat mental processes as an interaction between these various approaches.</p> <p>Course enrollment: requirements will be explained in the first class.</p>

 - *Self-rating: evaluate the contributions of other members in the group using 7-point scale. I will adjust your scores based on the rating.
- *Requirement for the individual report:**
Format: Double-space, 12-point font, Times New Roman, and a Word/PDF document. **Assignments could be written in Chinese (2500-3000 words)/English (1500-2000 words)** (File title should be named as: Name_Department_Report X).

 *Academic dishonesty is not allowed, including cheating and plagiarism will result in an "F" on your assignments/exams.
- **Extra credits:**
