- Decision Making capability be responsible and confident on making timely decisions in a new business and have good understanding how they relate to financial results.
- Critical Thinking skills be able to analyze complex business information and to make sound judgement.
- Entrepreneurial Teamwork / Leadership be able to lead and to collaborate with others effectively in a new organization that has additional constraints and uncertainties.

課程目標 Course Objectives

- To understand the essential mindset and mental models to run a new organization that needs clear vision while capped with constrained resources.
- To learn and practice the business decision making in new organization through collaborative work with team members in a Business Making Decision Simulation system. Participants will have the opportunities to play the roles of business leaders in simulated business competition.
- To analyze business results based on simulated Business Intelligence outputs financials and non-financials.
- To build up strong interactive capability in business group discussion to provide useful feedbacks, challenges and to help driving the new organization to succeed.
- *We refer "new organization" as either an initially established startup or a new business team in a corporate.

課程說明 Course Description

- This course is useful for students who are interested to understand the essentials in making business decisions in a new organization. They will gain "hands-on" experience through simulated system.
- Lectures on the critical elements of business decision making will be given. This helps the participants to have better understanding on key managerial concept needed in running a new organization.
- We will be using 8-Cross® Decision Making System ("8+®決策系統") to have simulated startup companies competing in a market. The participants will be acting as individual business leaders (such as CEO, CFO, COO) to make various decisions while collaborate among themselves in their simulated companies. It involves the decisions from product development, resource acquiring, production, sales & marketing, shareholder relationship, etc. The system will be providing Business Intelligence information, which includes financial and non-financial reports/metrics to facilitate the team in analyzing the performance and risks.
- The course will be running through in the combinations of lectures, business simulation and group discussions. Near the end of the class, business presentation and result reviews will be conducted. With these arrangements, the participants will be more capable to apply the management concept in real life new business. It is also similarly critical for them to learn vividly on why a new organization could easily fail upon bad decision. In another words, it is much better to learn such failures in a class than in real life.
- *Please note that each participant will need to pay <u>NT\$800</u> for using the Business Decision Making Simulation system. Additionally, a <u>NT\$150</u> is needed for the system Handbook. Total fee per member will be <u>NT\$950</u>.

教學方式 Teaching Approach

- a) Lectures.
- b) Business Decision Making Simulation an online multi-user business simulation system that the students will be assigned roles and teamed up in different starting up companies competing for financial results.
- c) Simulation Result Team Presentation and Review.
- d) Team discussions.
 - At each simulated month, the team may need to discuss (online possible) on the next decisions, which could consume 30~60min/day if the Simulation is kept running after normal classes, likely couple weeks each in March and April.
 - At the end of the whole class, a Final Presentation package is to be submitted by each team.
- * We may be moving to the Computer Room at certain weeks.

評分標準 Grading

Class participation, group discussions and personal contribution in the Simulation: 30%

Lecture reflection: 20%

- By the end of selected lectures (or within given days), a feedback form is to be submitted with feedbacks and key learning.

Business Decision Making Simulation Competition Result: 20%

- Simulated metrics such as stock price and essential financial metrics will be used to rate the result (competition ranking).

Final Presentation & Review: 30%

- The key learning and reflection from analyzing the competition result is more critical than merely having a great competition result of the team.

Grading may differ among the members within a team based on individual contribution.
