Course Objectives:

A successful project manager should have the ability to manage the team, schedules, and resources in order to achieve a desired outcome within a limited amount of time. This course will teach the technical tools and behavioral skills of project management required in different types or organizations, aiming to introduce the tasks, challenges, and functions of project management. It also seeks to take a practical, hands-on approach; the students will engage in ongoing projects in which they will apply the theories and knowledge from class in practice.

Teaching Arrangements:

Teaching will consist of lectures, case discussions, group presentations and site visit.

Lectures:

Each lecture will take 1.5 hours, and will mainly consist of the concepts, techniques and core theories of project management. <u>*Please note: all lectures will be taught in English.*</u>

Case Discussion (30%):

In the second half of each class, group case discussions will take place. From weeks 4 to 15, the instructor will assign a case to each individual group to lead the discussion session.

Final Project Presentation (40%):

During the course, each group will need to execute and present a project (separate from the project presentation from weeks 4 to 15). Each group will have flexibility in choosing their project and will then present it in the final weeks.
