<p>一、課程說明</p>	<p>Without online shopping and 7-11, do you know where to satisfy your daily life? Most of the students have no idea, because the convenience of life makes us forget these common sense, so that we are out of touch with our long-accumulated living culture. The fact that people are rapidly losing their traditional culture due to changing lifestyles is happening to us. The purpose of this class is to bridge the gap between modern people and traditional culture and to prevent us from treating our living space as strangers.</p> <p>Our city, Hsinchu, once had a rich cultural heritage. It has been under the rule of the Qing Dynasty, Japanese colonization, and the government of the Republic of China. The characteristics of the different eras have shaped the life of Hsinchu today.</p> <p>In the course, we will walk through the temples, alleys and buildings of Hsinchu in a situated learning style. We will learn about the culture, history and life in Hsinchu. At the end of the course, students will be asked to create a map of their life in Hsinchu as a guide for Travelers and to assess their grades.</p>

<p>四、教學方式</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The course takes 18 hours at last, which is equivalent to one hour of classroom time per week for one semester. The teaching methods are planned as follows: 4 hours of classroom teaching, 12 hours of fieldwork and discussion. One hour of individual guidance for final assignments. 2. The classroom lectures will focus on the introduction to the course and the relationship between fieldwork and various documents. Fieldwork will be conducted in the Hsinchu area to investigate the historical aspects of the Qing, Japanese and contemporary periods. At the end of the course, students will be required to produce a topic map of the Hsinchu for travelers. 3. Classes will be held in Classroom 109 of the Education Center, Hsinchu City, and Hsinchu Park, etc. 4. Insurance is required during the course and will be paid for by the

	students at a cost of approximately \$50.
