Course Goals / Description

中高級英文三聽講為一門 2 學分學期課程,為訓練中高級程度之大一學生習得進階主題 式英語溝通與表達,強化學生思考、組織及表達的整合技能;並培養學生發現問題、以 英語提問並表達意見的能力,經由實境口說與演講訓練,增進學生英語聽力及演說技巧。

General language skills

To develop students' essential 21st century skills:

- 1. To communicate clearly
- 2. To work independently and to be self-directed learners
- 3. To be exposed to multimedia presentations of information, to learn how to understand them and determine their effectiveness
- 4. To develop digital literacy skills
- 5. To think critically

Listening skills:

- 1. To comprehend main ideas, details, inferences, pronunciation, note-taking etc.
- 2. To activate students' background knowledge of the topic and help them personalize and relate to the theme
- 3. To promote students visual literacy through infographics

- 1. To apply presentation skills inspired by the TED speakers
- 2. To give students the skills and authentic language they need to successfully deliver their own presentations
- 3. To use graphic organizers to synthesize information and consolidate their learning
