Scott Fitzgerald's Short Stories

Course Description:

The course introduces the narrative art of Scott Fitzgerald's major short stories along with his most read novella, *The Great Gatsby*. Students will try to familiarize themselves with the major themes in the 20s (with the looming Great Depression in mind) and observe how the modernistic rhetoric of progress and disillusionment converge in Fitzgerald's short stories. In addition, students will be asked to practice close reading so as to further appreciate Fitzgerald's short stories that are full of ironies, parodies, and narrative cruxes.
