- 3.20世紀音樂語言
  - 12音技巧與無調性
  - 實踐演奏:選擇20世紀的曲目進行練習。
- 4. 音樂史:中世紀到文藝復興
  - Gregorian聖歌和早期多部聲音樂
  - 實踐演奏:學習並演奏Gregorian聖歌段落。
- 5. 音樂史: 巴洛克到古典
  - 儀式舞曲、奏鳴曲與交響曲的起源
  - 實踐演奏:選取巴洛克時期的短曲練習。
- 6. 音樂史:浪漫時期
  - 程式音樂與民族風格

- 實踐演奏: 選擇浪漫時期的小品進行演奏。
- 7. 音樂史: 20世紀到21世紀
  - 從後浪漫到當代音樂的流派
  - 實踐演奏:選取20-21世紀的曲目練習。
- 8. 樂器與編曲
  - 各種樂器的音色與技巧
  - \*\*實踐演奏\*\*: 學生將曲目重新編排並表演。
- 9. 音樂技術與創作
  - 基礎作曲技巧
  - \*\*實踐演奏\*\*:學生演奏自己的原創小品。
- 10. 演奏與詮釋
  - 分析與演奏的關聯
  - 實踐演奏: 學生根據分析結果詮釋特定曲目。
- 11. 音樂與文化
  - 音樂如何反映社會與文化
  - 實踐演奏: 選取具文化特色的曲目進行演奏。
- 12. 音樂分析實戰
  - 學生選擇作品進行深入分析
  - 實踐演奏:根據分析結果演奏選定曲目。
- 13. 室內樂與合奏技巧
  - 團體合作與聽力訓練
  - 實踐演奏: 小組形式進行合奏。
- 14. 當代音樂的詮釋與實踐
  - 現代樂譜的挑戰與演奏
  - 實踐演奏:演奏當代作曲家的作品。
- 15. 總結與回顧
  - 整合所學,討論進一步學習方向
  - 實踐演奏: 學生自選曲目進行演奏。
- 16. 學生研究報告與表演
  - 學生展示他們的分析、研究
  - 實踐演奏:每位學生表演一首自選曲目。

此課程大綱強調實際的演奏技能,讓學生能夠更直接地將所學的音樂知識和技巧應用於實際演奏中,達到真正的理論與實踐結合。

### Advanced Music Foundations: 16-Lesson Course Outline

In the 18-lesson course structure, mid-term and final examinations have been eliminated and replaced with assignments and presentations. Focus more on hands-on practice.

#### **Course Description**

This course aims to provide students with an intermediate knowledge of music with a deeper understanding of theory and techniques, emphasizing the importance of practical performance throughout the learning process.

### **Teaching Methods**

- 1. Lectures: Introduction to theoretical knowledge.
- 2. Aural Training: Analysis of musical works.
- 3. Practical Performance: Students apply their knowledge in actual performance.

  - Practical Performance: Choose and perform a piece from the Romantic era.
- 7. Music History: 20th to 21st Century
  - From post-romanticism to contemporary musical genres
  - Practical Performance: Select and practice a piece from the 20-21st century.
- 8. Instruments and Arrangement
  - Timbre and techniques of various instruments
  - \*\*Practical Performance\*\*: Students rearrange a piece and perform it.
- 9. Music Techniques and Composition
  - Basic composition techniques
  - Practical Performance: Students perform their original composition.
- 10. Performance and Interpretation
  - The relationship between analysis and performance
  - Practical Performance: Interpret and perform a specific piece based on analysis.
- 11. Music and Culture
  - How music reflects society and culture
  - Practical Performance: Perform a piece with cultural characteristics.
- 12. Hands-on Music Analysis
  - Students select a piece for in-depth analysis
  - Practical Performance: Perform the selected piece based on analysis.
- 13. Chamber Music and Ensemble Techniques
  - Group collaboration and aural training
  - Practical Performance: Ensemble performance in small groups.
- 14. Contemporary Music Interpretation and Practice
  - Challenges and performances of modern scores

- Practical Performance: Play a piece by a contemporary composer.

# 15. Summary and Review

- Integrate learning and discuss further learning directions
- Practical Performance: Students perform a piece of their choice.

### 16. Student Research Presentation and Performance

- Students showcase their analysis and research
- Practical Performance: Each student performs a selected piece.

This course outline emphasizes hands-on performance skills, allowing students to directly apply their musical knowledge and skills in actual performance, achieving a true integration of theory and practice.
