
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Course Overview

This course is designed for graduate students in iPhD program of NTHU to broaden their horizons in different areas. This course, students will be required to invite speakers from interdisciplinary areas of research to share their cutting-edge results. All students are encouraged to have interactions with the speakers. Please see the Syllabus for more details.

Course Policy (Tentative)

- 1. In this seminar, we have 12 talks in total (12 Attendances). Course introduction on September 13, and IPhD Orientation on September 27 are excluded.
- 2. Students are required to attend the seminar on time (Wed. 16:30) and the TAs will take your attendance.
- 3. To pass this course, students are required to
 - (1) Attend talks at least 10 times in total
 - (2) Team up, invite a speaker and host the speech on that day as a team.
 - (3) Ask 1 question to at least 2 different speakers during the semester and upload your questions and the responses from the speakers to eeclass platform before the evening of the next day (Thu. 18:00).
- 4. To facilitate the process of inviting a speaker, please follow the workflow shown below.



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Workflow:

- (1) Please find 4 teammates and fill out your
 - (1) group members, (2) reserve a date for the talk, and (3) propose 2 speakers to be reviewed by the instructor ASAP. HERE
- (2) The administration will review the proposed list and give an invitation priority so that students can proceed to the invitation.
- (3) Once the speaker accepts the invitation, the group can continue to schedule and confirm the details with the speaker.
- (4) After the talk is confirmed, the group sends a thank you email to the speaker to confirm the invitation (copy instructor and TA on the email)
- (5) Fill out the information of the speaker in the form <u>HERE</u>.
- (6) The team will have to host the speech do the opening, manage the Q&A session, and do the closing.

Fees: Transportation Fee (only public transportation could be claimed) + Speech fee (NTHU Professor: NT 2,000; others: NT 4,000)

P.S.

- 1. A foreign speaker will have to provide a copy of his or her ARC or passport prior to the talk and subject to the tax deduction.
- 2. For transportation fee, please use the physical ticket so that the speaker could hand in the ticket for the reimbursement.
- 3. Your final score will be calculated by
 - 70% (Minimum Requirement, Regulation 3)
 Attendance x 10+ Question report x2 + Speaker Invitation
 - Bonus (up to 30 points):
 - a. With one more attendance, you get extra 5 points.
 - b. With one more question (and report), you get extra 5 points (up to 20 points).
- 4. For the "Student Talk's week" we would like our students to get to know more about their classmates, we will ask for 2-3 voluntarily students to share their experiences 20 minutes to the class. Those who participate will receive extra 10 points
